LARKINS PALE: ABV 4.2%

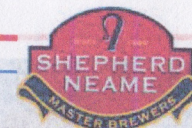
A full flavoured Kentish-style pale ale, packed with hops grown on Larkins Farm and with not a hint of grapefruit!
